RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Create a statewide plan for higher education.
- Ensure colleges successfully move students through precollege level courses, quickly and with improved retention rates.
- 3. Provide clear transfer pathways to four-year degrees.
- Expand college knowledge in middle and high school and invest in support services students need to succeed.

- 5. Grow state funding to expand enrollment capacity so all California eligible students have a spot in our public higher education system.
- 6. Strengthen financial support options for low- to moderateincome college students.
- 7. Use disaggregated data to improve educational outcomes for Asian American and NHPI students.
- 8. Ensure federal funding for Asian American and Native American Pacific Islander serving institutions is focused on student support and improving student outcomes for those students.
