Key Legislation to Fix Placement

Sponsored AB 705 authored by Assemblymember Jacqui Irwin, which ensures more students have access to collegelevel courses when they start community college by requiring colleges to use high school transcripts as a factor in determining course placement, substantially increasing students' chances of completing a degree, certificate or transfer.

M Stayed Vigilant on Transfer

Released, "The Transfer Maze: The High Cost to Students and the State of California," a report that shows we have work left to do to ensure every community college student who wants to transfer to the state's four-year universities has a clear roadmap to attain a bachelor's degree.

Supported Efforts to Uphold Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals

Convened groups to talk about ways to support and provide resources for DACA and undocumented students, participated in legislative news conferences calling on Congress to pass the DREAM Act, and pressed the Trump Administration to uphold DACA.

✓ A Focus on the State Budget

Advocated for an additional \$160 million for community colleges for proven student success efforts, \$150 million for guided pathways in the state budget and an additional \$700 million to expand enrollment.
